

REMOVE TIE DOWN EYE (TWO BOLTS UNDER CAR, ONE NUT IN TRUNK). 2. RAISE HITCH INTO POSITION AND LOOSELY SECURE TO VEHICLE AT TIE DOWN EYE LOCATION USING ORIGINAL M10 BOLTS. INSTALL REMAINING PASTENERS AS SHOWN ABOVE AND TIGHTEN ALL FASTENERS. SEAL HOLE LEFT IN TRUNK PAN BY REMOVAL OF TIE DOWN EYE TO PREVENT INTRUSION OF EXHAUST FUMES OR WATER AND RETURN TIE DOWN EYE WITH NUT TO VEHICLE OWNER.

6. RETURN JACK AND SPARE TIRE TO TRUNK.

TIGHTEN ALL M10 FASTENERS TO 42 LB-FT. TIGHTEN ALL 7/16 FASTENERS TO 50 LB-FT.

NOTE: Check hitch frequently, making sure all fasteners and ball are properly tightened. If hitch is removed, plug all holes in trunk pan or other body panels to prevent entry of water and exhaust fumes. A hitch or ball which has been damaged should be removed and replaced. Observe safety precautions when working beneath a vehicle and wear eye protection. Follow car maker's specs for maximum trailer weight and tongue weight. Do not cut access or attachment holes with a torch.
