

NOTES: A. This hitch features a removable ball mount. This hitch is not intended for use as a weight distributing hitch. Before towing, the hitch pin and retainer clip MUST be in place securing ball mount to receiver.

- B. This product complies with safety specifications and requirements for connecting devices and rowing systems of the state of New York and regulation V.E.S.C. V-5.
- 1. General Fit: This hitch mounts to vehicle at the bottom surface of bumper brackets above the exhaust tips on left and right sides and to the bottom of the trunk floor..
- 2. Place hitch in position centered on the vehicle and mark the bottom surface of humper brackets for holes (1).
- 3. Center punch and drill holes 11/2" diameter thru bottom surface of brackets. Using the fish wire method, pull 7/16" carriage bolt with #907 backing plate into holes 1 from inside bumper brackets accessing at opening at rear of brackets inside bumper channel. See figure A
- 4. Using washers and nuts called out at (1), bolt hitch in position at (1) being careful not to push carriage bolts back into frame.
- 5. Clear trunk area for drilling. Using hitch as a guide, drill trunk floor four places for 3/8" diameter screws. Fasten hitch at trunk floor using fasteners 2. Screws are palced from the inside with large diameter fender washers at each.
- 6. Final tighten all fasteners as specified on reverse of these instructions. Recheck fasteners occassionally.

 - (4) 3/8" lock washer
 - (4) 3/8" hex nut
